Detailed e-Procurement Notification

Sub: Tender for Supply of Green grass for the captive wild animals housed at different units in Bannerghatta Biological Park, Bengaluru



The Executive Director, Bannerghatta Biological Park, Bannerghatta, Bangalore herein after referred as tender Inviting Authority, has invited e-Tender from the reputed firms/contractor for supply of Green grass for the captive wild animals housed at different units in Bannerghatta Biological Park for one year from the date of agreement.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Tender form will be available in e-Procurement portal, <https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in> (Department Selection: Zoo Authority of Karnataka)
2. Tenders sent otherwise than through e-Procurement portal will not be considered.
3. In case of closure of the office of the undersigned due to unavoidable circumstances on the above date, tenders will be received and opened on the next day.
4. Tenders received late or those with incomplete information or not in accordance with the terms and conditions of this tender are liable for rejection.
5. The persons who are convicted in a court of law for offences involving moral turpitude in relation to his business dealing or black listed or insolvent or who have failed to pay the Government dues or who are minors will not be accepted and the earnest money deposit kept by them with the tenders will be liable to be forfeited to Zoo Authority of Karnataka.
6. The tender should be accompanied with prescribed **EMD** which shall be paid through e-Procurement portal.

7. Any tender submitted without the earnest money deposit (EMD) will not be accepted at any cost and shall stand rejected.
8. The EMD of the unsuccessful tenderers will be returned/ refunded after the tenders are finally accepted.
9. If the highest tenderer withdraws his offer after submission of his tender, the EMD paid by him in connection with this tender, shall be forfeited to Zoo Authority of Karnataka.
10. **The tender should be accompanied by Address Proof, Copy of PAN Card, Copy of GST registration, Copy of Aadhar card, Copy of Zoo registration and Income Tax Returns filed during the year 2018-19 and 2019-20.**
11. Conditional or telegraphic tender or tenders sent otherwise than through e-procurement will not be considered.
12. A Tender submitted/offered by more than one person shall not be accepted unless such persons are members of a registered company or firm and the tender submitted or made is on behalf of such company or firm. In case it is not possible for all the partners to sign the tender, there should be a power of attorney issued by the competent authority in favour of the person signing the tender and enclose the same to the tender form.
13. The tenderer/ contractor is liable to be disqualified at any stage of tender or contract if it is revealed that they have made false representation in forms, statements, affidavits and attachments submitted in proof of qualification required, and suitable action as deemed fit may be taken by the Executive Director, Bannerghatta Biological Park, Bangalore.
14. All the tenders shall remain open for acceptance by the competent authority for a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of the tenders. The date of notifying the orders of acceptance of the successful tenderers on the notice board of the office of the undersigned shall be deemed to be the date of communication of acceptance of the tender to the successful tenderer.
15. The Member Secretary (Zoo Authority of Karnataka) being the tender accepting authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without incurring any liability or obligation to inform the applicants of the reasons for such action.
16. **The successful Tenderer, within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of communication of acceptance of the tender shall deliver to the Employer a Security deposit for an amount equivalent to 10% of the tendered amount in the form of Demand Draft, Bankers Cheque, specified small savings instruments or irrevocable Bank guarantee and shall execute an agreement on a stamp paper of requisite value of ₹ 200/- as per Stamp Act. The security deposit shall be kept with the Executive Director, Bannerghatta Biological Park till the completion of the contract period, and released thereafter subject to satisfactory completion of tender period.**

17. The earnest money deposit of the successful Tenderer will be discharged when the Tenderer has signed the Agreement and furnished the required Security Deposit.
18. If the successful tenderer fails to come and enter into an agreement within 15 days of announcement/communication of the successful tenderer, an offer may be made to the second highest tenderer, and an agreement may be executed with him. In such case, the EMD furnished by the highest tenderer will be forfeited.
19. The total amount computed for all items of commodities in the unit at rates offered by individual tender will be considered for the acceptance as a unit of tender.
20. Tenderer should quote his rate per Kg which should be inclusive of all taxes
21. The quantities shown in the schedule are approximate. The requirement may increase or decrease depending upon the necessity. The tenderers are bound to supply the quantities at the accepted rates only.
22. The tenderer should supply the commodities as per regular indents placed by the Assistant Director (Veterinary Service) or Range Forest Officer (Zoo/Safari/Butterfly Park), BBP except under emergency conditions in which case only one day notice will be given. The commodities shall be got weighted at BBP and deposited at the scheduled place every day as per the scheduled time. The receipts in triplicate should be obtained then and there itself for the correct quantities delivered, as no complaints will be entertained later. Bills not supported by such receipt will not be paid.
23. The contractor shall supply the full quantity of indent placed which will be check measured by the Assistant Director (Veterinary Service)/Range Forest Officer (Zoo/Safari/Butterfly Park), BBP or any other officer authorized.
24. If due to infectious, disease, inferior quality of supply or due to short supply, there happens any death or ailment to any captive animal, the loss thereof shall be determined by the Executive Director and liable to be recovered from the contractor as per the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 and Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, his agreement may be terminated apart from initiating criminal proceedings.
25. The contractor should supply good and approved quality-feeding articles. He shall also replace the articles rejected due to inferior quality/infections the same day, failing which the Assistant Director (Veterinary Service)/Range Forest Officer Zoo, Safari & Butterfly Park, BBP will be at liberty to purchase them from elsewhere and debit the extra cost if any incurred thereby to the account of the contractor which may be recovered out of his bills and security deposit furnished by him, apart from the fine determined by the Executive Director.
26. For supplies made during the month, payment will be made as soon as possible, after tenth of the succeeding month on production of regular bills in triplicate and together with all connected vouchers and receipts with certificates from the Assistant Director (Veterinary Service)/Range Forest Officer (Zoo/Safari/Butterfly Park) on bills for each month supply.
27. The supplies that may be rejected on quality ground and the supplies that may not be required as a result of late compliance of the requisition will have to be removed at once and such consignment will lie at risk of the suppliers.
28. The contractor should furnish photo identity cards of the authorized agents who will physically give delivery of goods at the Bannerghatta Biological Park. Identity cards shall be provided by the contractor. Failing which they will not be admitted into the Bannerghatta Biological Park. It is made mandatory so as to distinguish from the unauthorized person entering into the park. The authorized employees of the contractor shall be responsible for all the commissions and omissions caused by them, and the undersigned will view such commissions and omissions as if they were committed by the contractor himself.
29. List of all the persons along with their address proof and one pass port photograph, who are employed by the contractor, shall be submitted to the office of the Executive Director, BBP for records
30. The person/firms should not engage addicted alcoholic/drug users on any job in the facility created in the schedule property since, this facility has to run to cater to the needs of national and international tourists.
31. The Zoo Authority of Karnataka shall not be liable in any manner for the non-implementation of various other laws like Labour Laws, Provident Fund Laws, etc. It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that these statutory obligations are discharged promptly.
32. The period of contract shall be for a period of **one year from the date of execution of agreement**. However, Executive Director, BBP Bangalore reserves the right to extend the

duration of the contract beyond original contract period, up to a period not exceeding three months. The contractor has to supply the green grass during the extended period at the same rates and conditions. In case of delay in finalization of next tender, the period can be extended on mutual agreement.

33. The contractor shall not engage any staff of Zoo Authority of Karnataka for any work.
34. The person/firms shall pay wages to their workers at the rates not less than minimum wages as notified by state Government from time to time, failing which, the person/firms will be responsible for all consequences.
35. The person/firms should not engage in employing any child labours
36. The person/firms will be responsible for making payment of pay & allowances, including PF, ESI, leave salary, bonus, etc., to the workers engaged by him.
37. The person/firms is solely responsible for all the claims and rights as guaranteed under Labour Act, Industrial Dispute Act or any other Acts in vogue for the workers engaged by him and the BBP will in no way be connected or concerned or responsible.
38. The contract shall not be sublet or transferred without written permission of the Executive Director, Bannerghatta Biological Park.
39. No other activities are allowed except the activities for which the tender is called for.
40. Income Tax, Surcharge on IT and other statutory taxes will be recovered from the bills of contractors as per rates applicable.
41. The tenderer should abide by the provisions of any other existing law in force, with regard to quality, transportation, taxation, etc., during the course of supply of feeding articles. BBP shall not be responsible for any violation committed by the tenderer
42. In the event of default by the contractor to carry out any of the tender or agreement conditions, the Zoo Authority of Karnataka (ZAK) may impose any penalty as deemed appropriate. It may even forfeit the EMD of the tenderer, or any other alternative arrangement may be made. The loss caused to ZAK on account of re-tender if any shall be recoverable from the defaulting tenderer as an arrears to ZAK as per existing rules. Defaulting tenderer, will however have no right to claim profit, if any, accruing due to the tender
43. For any infringement of the conditions laid down in the agreement, the contractor is liable to pay the penalty of suitable amount as determined by the Executive Director, Bannerghatta Biological Park. The penalty shall be paid by the contractor within seven days. In case of severe infringements, the Executive Director reserves the right to cancel the agreement. In case of cancellation of the contract alternate arrangement will be made to get the supplies either in the open market or by calling fresh quotations at the risk and cost of the original tenderer.
44. Besides the above conditions, any additional conditions found necessary will be added at the time of execution of agreement.
45. If there is a prima facie case of violation of any of the above conditions of this contract by the tenderer, the tenderer is liable for legal action/penalty/forfeiture of security deposit/black listing/termination of contract/temporary suspension of contract, depending upon the gravity of omissions and commissions. These tender conditions shall form part and parcel of the tender agreement to be executed with the successful tenderer.
46. These tender conditions shall form part and parcel of the tender agreement to be executed with the successful tenderer.
47. In all matters of dispute pertaining to this contract between the contractor and the undersigned, the matter will be referred to the Member Secretary, Zoo Authority of Karnataka, Mysore, whose decision will be final and legally binding.
48. All appeals shall lie with the Member Secretary, Zoo Authority of Karnataka, Mysore, whose decision shall be final and binding in all matters pertaining to this contract
